Information about Camp Duncan

Camp Duncan pays for required J-1 visa processing fees, insurance and pays a weekly stipend (US\$130.00 per week the first 6 months, US\$140.00 per week for the second 6 months) and a \$250.00 bonus is added after completion of the training program.

All Camp Duncan international staff members live in a new dormitory; rooms sleep 4-6 people.

Days can be long, beginning as early as 6 AM and ending at 7 PM. In addition to summer camp, groups (i.e. Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, church groups, schools, Dads & Daughters, universities and others).
